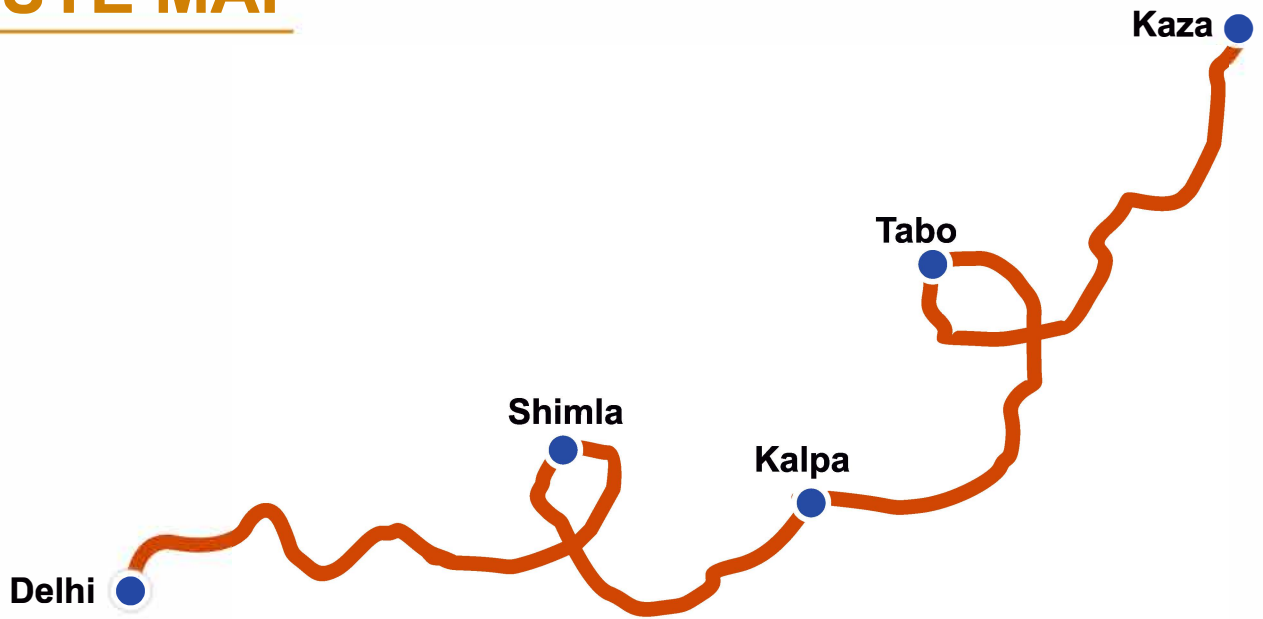

DAY 0: Delhi to Shimla overnight journey.

DAY 1: Arrival in Shimla and transfer to Kalpa.

DAY 2: Journey from Kalpa to Tabo via Nako.

DAY 3: Tabo to Kaza Explore Dhankar Monastery and Pin Valley.

DAY 4: Kaza Local sightseeing (Hikkim, Comic & Langza) .

DAY 5: Return journey to Kalpa.

DAY 6: Drive from Kalpa to Sangla.

DAY 7: Departure to Shimla and overnight transfer to Delhi.

DAY 8: Arrival in Delhi by morning.





Overview

The Spiti Valley Winter Expedition is a must for any adventure seeker who wants an authentic Spiti Valley tour through the winter months. Winter embraces Spiti in the first week of November and stays on till March. It is a cold and tough time in the valley, making it difficult yet extremely rewarding at the same time!

Everything is covered in a cloak of white for as far as the eyes can see. The Spiti River is more or less frozen up owing to the temperature falling till -20 degree Celsius. During these months, the famous Manali – Rohtang Pass – Kunzum La – Kaza road closes due to heavy snowfall. Hence, the only way to reach Spiti Valley is through the Hindustan Tibet Highway (Shimla – Kalpa – Kaza). We will be using this road both ways – to enter and exit the Spiti Valley.





Day 01

Shimla to Kalpa

- Our journey by arriving at Shimla bus stand in the morning.
- Traverse the scenic route through Kufri and Narkanda, following the Indo-Tibetan highway on your way to Kalpa.
- Reach the captivating destination of Kalpa by evening.
- Conclude the day with a delightful dinner and a restful night in Kalpa.





Day 02

Kalpa to Tabo via Nako - Tabo - Ka Loops

- Start your day early and have Breakfast.
- After a satisfying breakfast, proceed from Kalpa to Tabo, passing through Nako and the mesmerizing Ka Loops.
- En route, explore the quaint Nako village.
- Reach Tabo by evening and visit the ancient Tabo Monastery, the oldest in Spiti Valley.
- Conclude the day with dinner and a restful overnight stay in Tabo.





Day 03

Tabo to Kaza via Dhankar Monastery & Pin Valley

- Begin your day early with a hearty breakfast.
- Head to Dhankar Village, where you'll visit the historic Dhankar Monastery.
- Enjoy a scenic drive through Pin Valley, making stops at the Tailing Hanging Bridge and Mudh Village.
- Dinner and an overnight stay in Kaza.





Day 04

Kaza Sightseeing - Key Monastery, Chicham Bridge, Hikkim, Komik & Langza

- Wake up early and have breakfast.
- Explore the highlights of Kaza, including Key Monastery, Chicham Bridge, Hikkim, Komik, and Langza.
- Conclude the day with dinner and a comfortable overnight stay in Kaza.





Day 05

Journey to Kalpa

- Have a great Breakfast, Embark on the picturesque journey to Kalpa, soaking in the scenic beauty along the way
- Arrive in Kalpa by nightfall, welcomed by the tranquillity and charm of this enchanting destination.
- Enjoy a delightful dinner and settle in for a restful overnight stay in Kalpa.





Day 06

Kalpa to Sangla

- After having breakfast, Explore the renowned Cliff Point of Kalpa in Roghi village.
- Weather permitting, embark on a scenic drive to the Last Indian Village, Chitkul.
- Dinner and an overnight stay in a hotel at Sangla.





Day 07

Journey to Shimla and Overnight Transfer to Delhi

- Begin the day with breakfast before embarking on our journey to Shimla.
- Enjoy the Journey along the winding roads, tracing the path of the Satluj River
- After Reaching Shimla board the overnight transfer to Delhi.





Inclusions

- Transportation & Sightseeing in comfortable & hygienic vehicle from Shimla to Shimla.
- Volvo Bus from Delhi to Shimla and return.
- Accommodations on a Double-sharing basis as per itinerary.
- Meals – Breakfast & Dinner Starting From Day 1 Dinner to Day 7 Breakfast.
- Driver Night Charges, Toll Tax, Parking Charges, etc.





Exclusions

- Additional accommodation/food costs incurred due to any travel delay.
- Any lunch and other meals not mentioned in Package Inclusions.
- Any Airfare / Rail fare other than what is mentioned in “Inclusions” or any type of transportation.
- Additional Costs due to Flight Cancellations, Landslides, Roadblocks, and other natural calamities.
- Any other services not specified above in inclusions.



Payment Policy :

- To 'Confirm Your Booking', a minimum of 10% of the Total Booking Value must be deposited within 24 hours of booking the trip.
- 30% of the Total Billing Amount to be deposited as the booking amount at the time of the booking
- Remainder 70% of the Total Billing Amount to be deposited before 30 days of the departure date
- Failure to adhere to the Payment Policy can lead to a cancellation of the booking without any prior notice to the booking person.

Cancellation Policy-

- Any cancellations made up to 30 days prior the departure date would attract a 20% cancellation of the total ticket value.
- Any cancellations made within 30 days of the departure date would attract 100% cancellation of the total ticket value.
- Fail to do the 30% amount within a month of the booking or 3 months prior to the travel date, whichever is sooner, the booking will stand canceled without any prior intimation, and the amount received by The Nomadic Trails will be forfeited with no refund.
